PURPOSE

REACH *riders in our area of South Jersey with Jesus Christ.*

TEACH *riders in our area of South Jersey to live for Jesus Christ.*

BUILD *a network of riders in our area of South Jersey who will serve Jesus Christ.*

VISION

Our vision is to be a ministry that provides the Christian motorcyclist a vehicle in which they may challenge themselves to grow in their faith and thereby empower them to be the “salt and light of the earth” according to Matthew 5:13-15. This growth and empowerment then springs them into action for mission.

MISSION

Our mission is based on the “Great Commission” found in Mathew 28:18-20, “*And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.*”, leading people to a faith in Jesus Christ, being committed to God’s Word, and progressively growing towards Godliness in our daily lives – in all that we think, say, and do.

OUR STATEMENT OF FAITH

WE BELIEVE:

1. The Bible is the inspired and only infallible and authoritative written Word of God. (*II Tim. 3:16; I Peter 1:21*)
2. There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost. (*Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19*)
3. In the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal future return to this earth in power and glory to rule a thousand years. (*Matt. 1:23; Heb. 7:26; Acts 2:22; I Cor. 15:3; Matt. 28:6; Acts 1:9*)
4. That regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for the salvation of lost and sinful man, and that this salvation is received through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ as Messiah, Savior and Lord, and not as the result of good works. (*Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5*)
5. In the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a holy life and perform service that is pleasing to the Lord. (*Gal. 5:16-25*)
6. In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, the one to everlasting life and the other to everlasting damnation. (*Rev. 20:11-15*)

GUIDELINES

WHAT WE ARE NOT:

1. We are not a church nor are we affiliated with any denominational group. FRMM is a Christian ministry that supports the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We encourage all our members to attend and support a local Bible-believing church where Christ is honored, the Bible is taught, and everyone is welcome.
2. We are not a “gang or club”. We are prayerfully a group of motorcycle riders who love God, live for God, and serve God hence we are a “Faithful Motorcycle Riders Ministry” for God the Father, through the shed blood of our Saviour Jesus Christ, and empowered for service by the Holy Spirit.
3. We are not in competition with other motorcycle ministries, churches, clubs, or gangs. FRMM is an "open arms" ministry. Our goal is to promote Christian fellowship and to help Christians grow in their faith and share the message of Jesus Christ with the unsaved. We also seek unity within the church at large, which is the body of Christ, as we are all brothers and sisters in Christ regardless of church denomination, group labels, or style of worship. We will never prohibit members from attending church services, bible studies, or other fellowship groups. We welcome cooperation from any other church body, and as an "open arms" ministry, we hope that members from other ministries will freely fellowship with us.
4. We are not about gaining attention or admiration from others. Our main focus is what Jesus commanded all Christians to do. Jesus calls every Christian to step out in faith and spread the Gospel message.
5. We are not about idolizing the biker lifestyle. We are not about wanting to look cool and emulate how a biker looks. Our patch set and member t-shirts are meant as a visual reminder to us and to educate others of what Jesus Christ did on the cross for our sins. These items are also used to establish the identification of our ministry in the motorcycle community.
